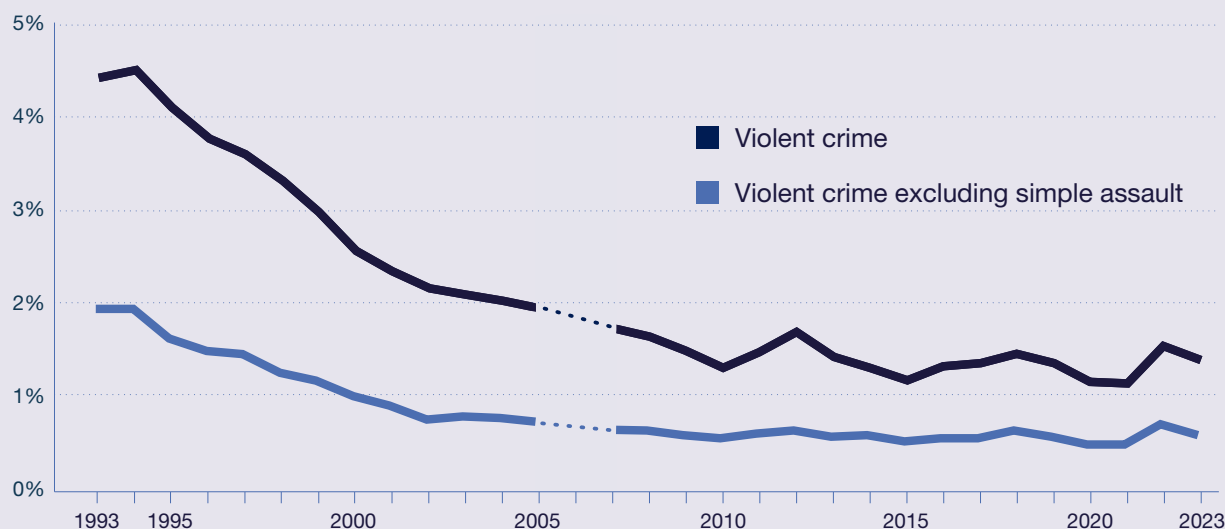


Key Findings from the 2023 NCVS: Prevalence

Prevalence represents the number or percentage of unique persons who were crime victims, or of unique households that experienced crime

In the United States, **1.36%** of persons age 12 or older experienced at least one violent crime



Estimates for 2006 should not be compared to those for other years.

Violent crime

rape or sexual assault, robbery, aggravated assault, and simple assault

Property crime

burglary or trespassing, motor vehicle theft, and other types of household theft
