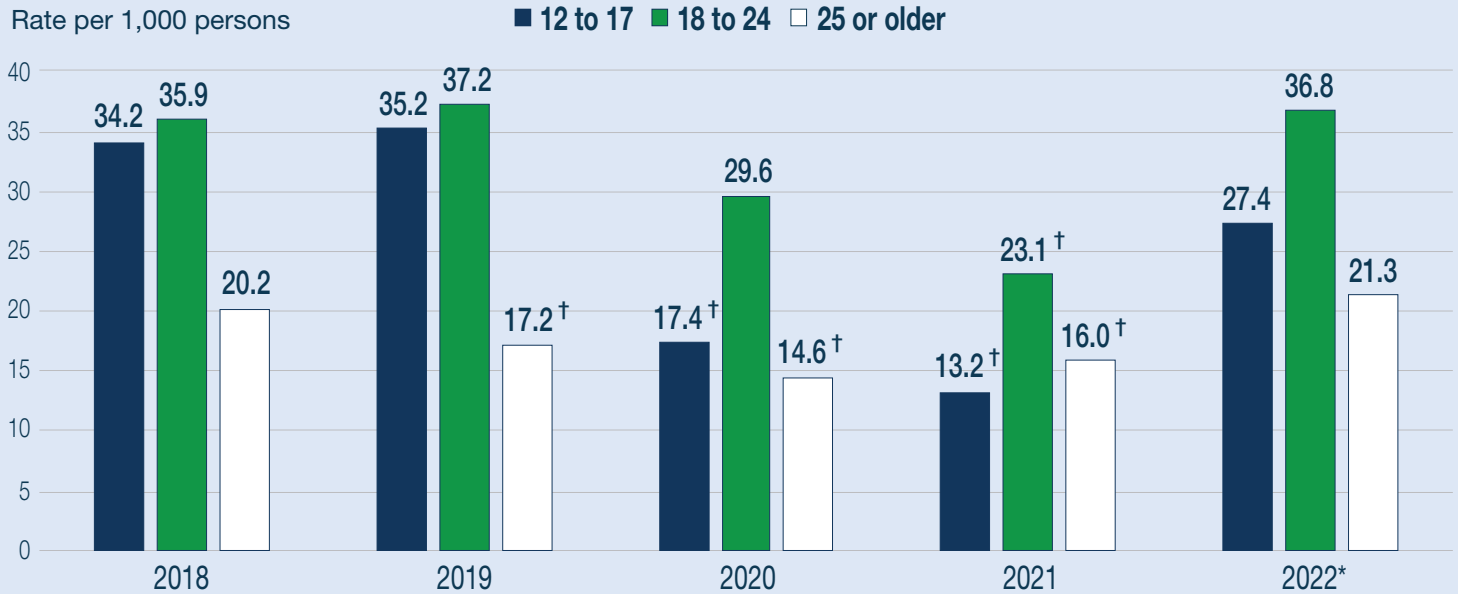


# Juvenile Victimization Trends in the United States

The rate of nonfatal violent victimization for persons ages 12 to 17 was higher in 2022 than in 2020 and 2021. The 2018 rate was not statistically different from the 2022 rate.

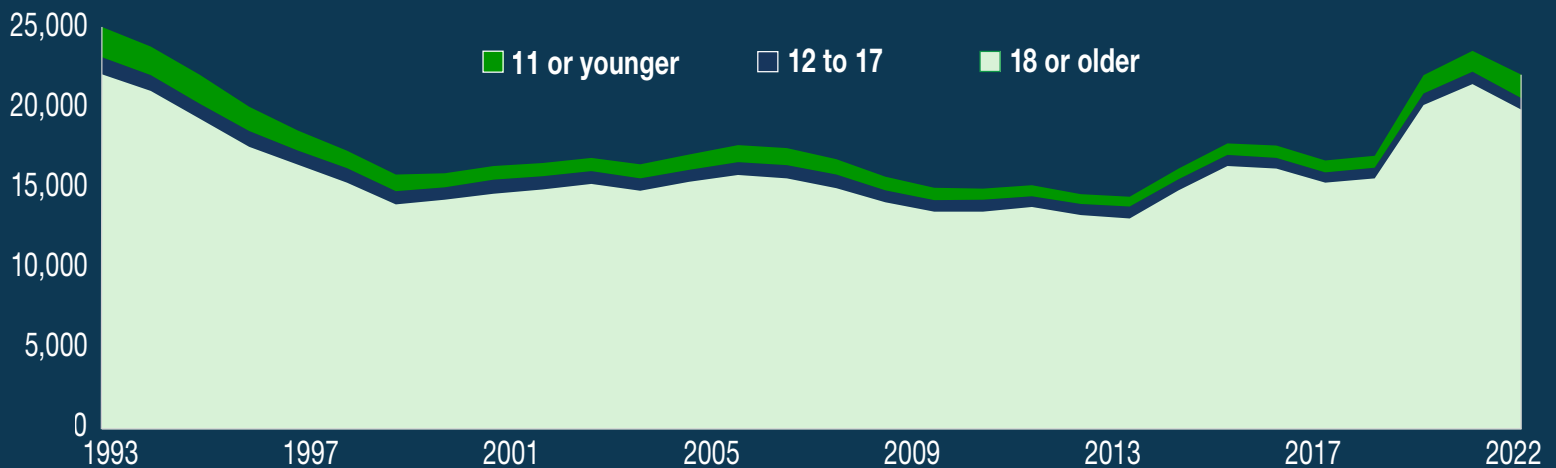


**Note:** Nonfatal violent victimization includes rape or sexual assault, robbery, aggravated assault, and simple assault.

In 2022, **710** youth age 11 or younger and **1,410** adolescents ages 12 to 17 were homicide victims.
