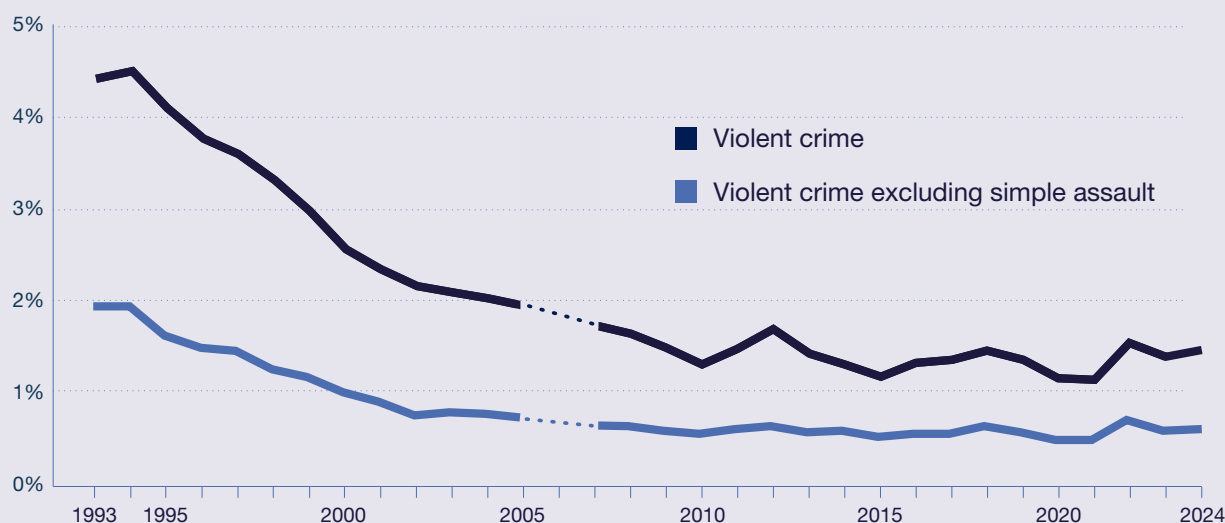


# Key Findings from the 2024 NCVS: Prevalence

**Prevalence** represents the number or percentage of unique persons who were crime victims, or of unique households that experienced crime

In the United States, **1.45%** of persons age 12 or older experienced at least one violent crime



Estimates for 2006 should not be compared to those for other years.

## Violent crime

rape or sexual assault, robbery, aggravated assault, and simple assault

## Property crime

burglary or trespassing, motor vehicle theft, and other types of household theft

**7.34%**
