| <b>Sexual assault</b>                        | 1,233  | 38.1%                                 |
| Male victim                                  | 201    | 6.2                                   |
| Female victim                                | 1,032  | 31.9                                  |
| <b>Non-sexual violent crime</b>              | 2,005  | 61.9%                                 |
| Male victim                                  | 1,072  | 33.1                                  |
| Female victim                                | 933    | 28.8                                  |
